



Present a Call for Entries:
High School Student Photographic Juried Show
Theme: “Waterscapes”

D&R Greenway Land Trust preserves land to offer you open spaces in which to play and create. Please photograph a natural landscape and manipulate it digitally into your vision of the future. Your image may or may not begin with a waterway or other body of water. You may show people interacting with water, or illustrate the importance of water to the biosphere and/or other feature(s) of water: go where your imagination takes you. Your manipulations can be subtle or dramatic as long as your work is nature-themed and has a strong water-based component.

Digital submission dates & information:

Submission deadline: Mon. Feb 20th

Requirements & Eligibility: High School students may submit up to three jpeg images to tiffanyso@drgreenway.org sized to 1200 pixels on the longest side at 72 ppi output.

Each image should be accompanied with your name (last name_first name), e-mail address, what high school you are attending, the title of the image, size of framed image, medium, sale price, and insurance value within the e-mail.

Attached to the image itself should be a bottom canvas with the title of your image and your name.

How to prepare the image:

Resize the image to make it 1200 pixels longest side with 72 ppi output resolution. Please write the title followed by the photographer's name (last name_first name) at the bottom, on an added canvas, sized 16 pixels. The font is Arial Narrow Italic, size 12, black color.

How to add the canvas:

Open the image, resize it to 1200 pixels longest side, then in the same Image menu go to 'canvas size', and proceed. Remember to choose background, foreground, or just white color of the canvas (at the bottom). After you have the canvas, use the type tool to write the title and your name. (Letter T on the keyboard is a shortcut).

Images must be matted and framed, covered with glass or Plexiglass, and wired for hanging.
No clip frames.

Place a label on the back of your image with the title, your name, contact information, high school you attend, medium, and sale price.
