TAKE NOTICE that the City of Trenton is proposing to change the purpose or use of .02 acres of Capital City Farm (CCF) from agriculture and open space to community center.

The Trenton Area Soup Kitchen (TASK) will be expanding its facility to better serve the residents of the area. TASK has been a partner with CCF from its inception. The additional education space will provide for TASK and CCF to partner in providing nutrition related education for area residents and patrons of TASK.
